### SPRING LAMBS - 119

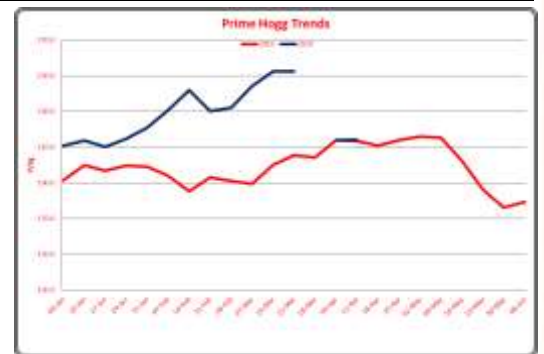
