Special Sale of 39 TB RESTRICTED STORE CATTLE

A TB sale to provide some top quality cattle to be offered to the largest ring-full of purchasers seen in Hereford for a restricted sale. Over 10 purchasers attended with the quality entry the attraction.

Steers topped at £1275 (555kg) for K & G Harrington, part of a marvellous run of Limousin cattle. Others to £1205 and £1165, with all Messrs **Harrington's steers over £1000 (220-247p/kg)**.

Heifers topped at £1260 (530kg) for another super run from W Jones. Craigol, who sold other smart heifers at £1250 and £1215, with several other heifers over £1100.

Angus steers to £1045 for Messrs Palliser. Angus bulls to £1085 from the same home.

We will conduct a sale providing we have sufficient numbers of cattle to offer, otherwise we will continue to sell TB restricted cattle farm to farm. Issues with licences make these markets hard work for all concerned, with **one vendor failing to get a licence for today's sale.**
