Suffolk yearlings to £160, £155, £153 and several pens between £130 and £150. 3's and 4's to £134 and £132. Older ewes from £100 to £120. Very few Mules on offer with only aged North Country Mules from £90 to £100.

Top of the day went to a pair of Beltex 2 year olds at £210 with others similar bred at £160 and £150. Very few pens unsold at the end of the sale.

A good entry with a better show of lambs presented and no hill bred lambs on offer. A large ringside of purchasers with some travelling Welsh men with grass starting to appear. Fewer stronger lambs this week but these all trading £80 to £96. Several large bunches over £80 with these £80 to £85, a remarkable trade for mid-August.

Farming lambs very similar on the week - those well bred lambs from £74 to £80, Several bunches trading from £76 to £79.50. A good show of medium keeping lambs - these well sold throughout and seeing plenty trading from £68 to £73.50, with smart bunches £70 plus.

Another week to see plenty of longer keeping lambs forward - these seeing the better bred types all £60 to £65. Plainer and smaller types £50 to £60. Very small and backward lambs all £40 to £48.

Several ram lambs - again these seeing the strongest sorts from £77 to £85.50. Large bunches trading over £80. Farming ram lambs nearly all £70 to £76.50. Smaller types generally all £60 to £69.50. Only very small and plain types £40 to £55. With our current grass situation the lambs look well sold and vendors are advised to keep selling.
