YEARLING EWES - 1486

A marvellous show of 1486 yearling ewes met a fantastic trade and one of the dearest seen in Hereford. A very strong Welsh contingent from both Mid and West Wales competed extremely strongly with the locals to source quality breeding ewes. Texel x ewes topped at £218 for a super consignment from M/s W E & M G Morgan, Tyngarn who sold others to £215 and £202. Suffolk x Mules from the same home to £212, other Suffolk x Mules to £190, part of another good run from Mr J Morgan, Tynllwyn who sold Texels to the same price. M/s A E & V Albutt topped at £186 for Suffolk x Mules and others to £181. Mr J T Hartland and Mr T L Whittal all passed the £180-mark and sold plenty in the £170's. Customers all wanting strong well backed ewes and were willing to pay for the right goods. Plenty of runs of both Suffolk x and Texel x Mules trading £160 to £170.

Smaller Texel x and Suffolk x yearlings from £140 to £155. Welsh Mules to £158 twice for white faced, other coloured and whites over £140. Many more could have been sold with several purchasers leaving without sheep. A large entry will be needed for our next special sale of yearlings on 1st September.

A similar entry of lambs with a good ringside of purchasers and trade excellent throughout. Again a shortage of stronger bunches with several large runs of long term lambs and more small Welsh sorts. The strength and meat easy to place and all £78 to £87.50. Several bunches of ram lambs and clean over £80. 50 Suffolk x wethers to £80. 4 pedigree Texel rams to £200!!

Farming lambs £72 to £77.50 and easy to place - more needed for each sale. Plainer lambs from £67 to £71.50, well bred medium keeping lambs £64 to £70 with level bunches easy to place. Longer term lambs trading from £54 to £60 for the better bred lambs. Smaller, harder bred sorts from £48 to £53.50. Very small sorts from £25 to £40 depending on size and meat.

Several ram lambs - the strongest all £80 to £87.50. Farming sorts £67 to £74. Smaller types then £55 to £65 throughout and look some of the dearest sold.
