BREEDING EWES - 1755

As expected, not the show of last week but nevertheless plenty of money for the better end. Top price of £170 for Suffolk yearlings from David Hartland on a day when the Suffolk sheep were easy to dispatch. Next highest Suffolk yearlings at £160, with several between £145 and £155.

Middle range pens from £130 to £145. Strong Texels also enjoyed a good day with a top price of £165 for both John Watkins and Ray Rogers. Other pens from £150 to £160. Next size down then from £120 to £135, 2 years to £130, with other similar age in the £120's.

Prices achieved for Welsh Mule yearlings pleased many vendors with a top of £160 and again at £150. Smaller pens of the same breed from £105 to £130. Flock age Welsh Mules around £100. North Country Mule yearlings to £135 (twice) with older ewes around £100. A run of Cheviot ewes (lost tooth) sold to £68. Welsh yearling ewes to £102. An excellent clearance effected with very few unsold at the end of the sale.

Another good entry met a strong trade with a good crowd of purchasers including several Welshmen. A good show of lambs although not too many runs of strong stores, the strongest to £89, with several bunches £76 to £81.80, these no less on the week. Farming lambs £70 to £75.50 throughout. Well bred Texel and Charollais lambs £74 to £76 with plenty of bunches trading around mid £70's.

A large show of medium keeping lambs - these £64 to £70 throughout the day, including an excellent run of Welsh Mule wethers - these trading £68 to £71.20. The longer keeping lambs in places sharper than last week although several small and plain lambs on show. The well bred nicer sorts £60 to £63.50, with these easy to place.

Plainer and poorer bred types £54 to £59.50, these include some small Welsh and Speckle wethers. The very small and plain £40 to £48 with very little under £40.

Ram lambs less in number - the stronger ram lambs £75 to £80, several bunches late £70's. Farming sorts from £68 to £74, any strength all £72 to £75 with potential. Longer keeping and hill bred sorts from £50 to £65 depending on size and condition.
