The second sale of yearling ewes, as always brought a super show of sheep and a crowd of purchasers to appreciate them. Mid and North Wales well represented as well as Herefordshire and all adjoining counties. Top price of £200 for a lovely pen of Cheviot Mules from Emlyn Morgan, Tyngarn with the top of the Texels to Messrs Davies, Maentwylch, at £190. Smart Texels trading all day between £160 and £180, Messrs J T Hartland again showing a super run of Texels to £180 and £172, T Badger to £175 and £170 with plenty £155 to £165. Suffolk x Mules topped at £185.

Like the first sale in August plenty of pens trading from £160 to £170 for the strongest, smart headed farming Suffolk x Mules from £145 to £158, with no end of pens £150 plus. Smaller Suffolk x Mules look the dearest from £130 to £140. Demand all day for the Suffolk x Mules. Smaller Texel x Mules £135 to £150 depending on condition and again finding no end of customers. Smaller pens of both breeds from £130 to £150. Welsh Mules to £162, most business done between £140 and £155. North Country Mules to £138. A complete clearance effected at an average of £155.53.

Just under 3000 lambs met a strong trade throughout to a larger ringside of purchasers. Strongest lambs taking a nice lift on the week topping at £89 for a bunch of 26 Charollais x lambs, several large bunches trading past £80. Farming lambs sharper on the week, these £73 to £79 throughout, again the well bred lambs all £75 to £79. A large show of medium keeping lambs, some of these starting to get plainer, however trade stand-on from last week with plenty £65 to £70, no end of bunches late £60's. Plainer sorts £60 to £64.50 and maybe a little less money. Longer term lambs slightly easier with several of these forward, the well bred types £55 to £60. Plainer and harder bred types from £50 to £55. Several small types, these from £35 to £47 and looking well sold.

Another large entry of ram lambs, any strength £70 to £80. Farming ram lambs £64 to £69.50. Plainer and poorer bred sorts from £55 to £64.50.
