A good entry of over 2000 lambs, with trade sharper on the week with increased buying support. Heavier lambs dearer on the week, topping at £104.50 from G E & M J Powell, others to £101, several pens trading £92 to £99. Export weight lambs seeing the best at 195-205p/kg, although mainly seeing the lambs £80 to £85. Handy weight 36-38kg a good trade, with these smarter types 205-215p/kg. The smalls also dearer on the week with all the lights averaging just under 190p/kg. Smartest sorts all 200-218p/kg, with hill lambs generally 180-190p/kg.

Another large entry of breeding ewes and good under, with just under 1300 ewes penned and sold. A Suffolk 2 year old ram to £260 from M/s E P Hughes & Co, Porth. The dispersal from D W & E M Pugh sold to excellent interest and topped at £130 for some Welsh Mule 3's, others trading £106 to £120 for 2's and 3's. The full mouth ewes £90 to £100. Several good pens of Welsh Mule broken mouth ewes, these trading £80 to £84.50 for the strongest with the plainer types £75 to £80. A large show of Welsh and Speckles with the stronger end of these still £60 to £70. The stronger plainer types £50 to £60. Several hard bred ewes and smaller Speckles, these generally all £40 to £50, with only a handful of pens in the late £30's.

Purchaser spaces will be limited in the sale ring therefore only ONE person per business will be allowed entry to the sale ring.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times.
