STORE LAMBS - 6022

Just over 6000 lambs with a large ringside of purchasers, a large travelling contingent with lambs going to all parts of the country and in truth a larger entry was required. Trade very animated throughout with the strength trading £84 to £93.50. Several bunches trading £87 to £92.20. Smart Texels in real favour topping at £90.50 from I T Davies & Son, Brecon, others to £89.50 and £89.00 and several pens of those smart sorts £80 to £90. Another excellent show in both numbers and quality of farming lambs, the strongest and better sorts all £80 to £83.50, well bred but slightly smaller lambs £76 to £79.50, these sticking a tremendous trade throughout with several lambs in the last 500 sold still £80 to £83.

A nice show of medium keeping lambs these trading £70 to £75 for the well bred types, several good runs of Welsh Mule wethers as normal for November, these topped at £85 from A M Jones and others to £84.20 for a tremendous bunch of 60 from I M Goodwin, another very good run from T D Rogers to £79 with others to £77, smaller sorts nearly all £70 to £74. Harder bred types and plainer lambs £66 to £69.50 but still finding plenty of customers.

A larger show of longer term and smaller hill type lambs, the well bred long term lambs £60 to £67 depending on strength and condition, plainer types generally £54 to £60. Harder bred and hill types trading £50 to £65 again depending on condition, with very few lambs under £50!!

Several ram lambs - these topped at £93.50 with the strength all £80 plus, farming sorts from £74 to £79.50 depending on condition and frame. Several smaller and plainer types - these £55 to £65 depending on condition and strength. Still some ewe lambs on show, pure Texels to £136, others from £104 to £114. Suffolk cross Mules to £100, Welsh Mules topped at £98 with other smarter headed types £80 to £86 but finding customers.

Another large entry will be required next week - 6000 plus lambs with numbers and quality certainly attracting purchasers to Hereford to source lambs. Many thanks to all vendors for your cooperation with the drop and go policy and your continued support each week.

Purchaser spaces will be limited in the sale ring therefore only ONE person per business will be allowed entry to the sale ring.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times.

To facilitate the Test and Trace system, all customers/visitors will be required to sign into the market. This process will include a declaration that they have not been in contact with anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19, nor are displaying symptoms personally.
