## **STORE LAMBS - 7548**

A record entry of store lambs in Hereford and what a day!! Again a fantastic trade throughout which held right through the entry with several bunches in the last 500 lambs sold from £80 to £89.50. All shapes and sizes wanted with another strong crowd of purchasers and sheep going all over the country.

Genuine stores to £99.50 for strong Texel ram lambs, several large bunches trading from £90 to £95.80. A super bunch of 50 Texels from Mr D Powell, Cilwhybert Farm, Brecon to £90. Strength trading from £85 to £95 throughout.

Another fantastic show of farming lambs, these trading from £78 to £84.50, with no end of lambs selling £80 to £84. Smart Texels and Beltex in real demand - these stronger types £82 to £90. Even small, shapely lambs from £70 to £80, with most nearly all £77 to £80.

Level bunches of well bred Suffolks and Texels £80 plus all through the sale. An excellent run from Mr T Anthony topped at £85.80 and averaged £82.81 for 250 continental lambs. Several Mule wethers again, the best to £83.20. Several bunches from £75 to £80.20, with no real strength on show. Smaller running Mule wethers nearly all £70 to £74.50.

Several well bred medium keep lambs - the smartest types with condition trading from £72 to £76.50 with plenty of these mid £70's. Harder bred lambs £68 to £73 depending on condition. The 300 Welsh wethers from one farm topped at £77, with other large bunches at £74, £70 twice and £61. Smaller Aberfield x lambs from £60 to £72 depending on frame. Plainer lambs no dearer and generally £62 to £67. The best longer-keep lambs from £62 to £67, anything with condition nearly all £60 plus, plainer types from £50 to £60.

Several ram lambs this week, the strongest to £99.50, with several larger bunches of ram lambs trading from £88 to £95.80. Any frame with condition nearly all £80 plus. A bunch of Cheviot ram lambs to £89.80. Farming types trading from £74 to £80 depending on breed and condition, this to include several Welsh and Mule ram lambs. Medium types from £68 to £73.50 depending on potential. Smaller, hill type and backward lambs from £52 to £62, with very few under £50.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.
