Another superb lamb trade to average 231p/kg up to 258p/kg for a pen of 34kg from Mr M Lloyd, Poolwharf that soared to £87.80/head. Whilst the trade was strong there was some resistance which was reflective in some of those thicker types. The dearest lambs by far were those up to 42kg, with the top 20 prices all over 242p/kg and all of which ranged between 34kg and 42kg. A smart pen of 38.5kg from Mr A Baker, Dunswater selling to £98/head or 255p/kg. The real highlight of the day were the heavies, especially the 48kg plus lambs that ranged from £100 to £110 depending upon quality. A nice pen of 49kg selling to £113/head. Those 50kg were £110 plus topping at £118.50/head for 55kg from M/s Morgan & Co. Every pen in the market averaged £98.26/head. A very good end to the year!

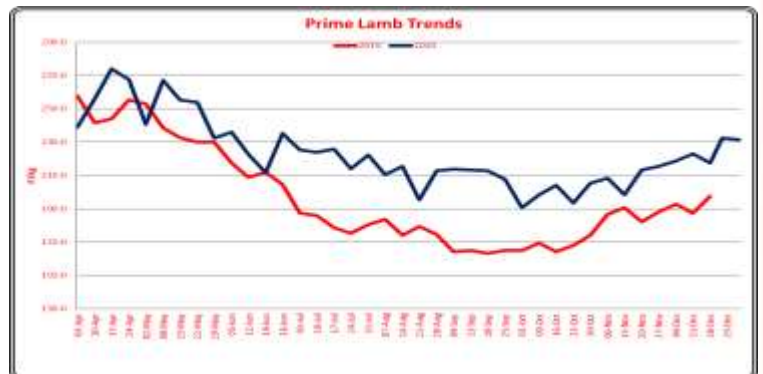



Purchaser spaces will be limited in the sale ring therefore only ONE person per business will be allowed entry to the sale ring.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times. Gloves are recommended.
