

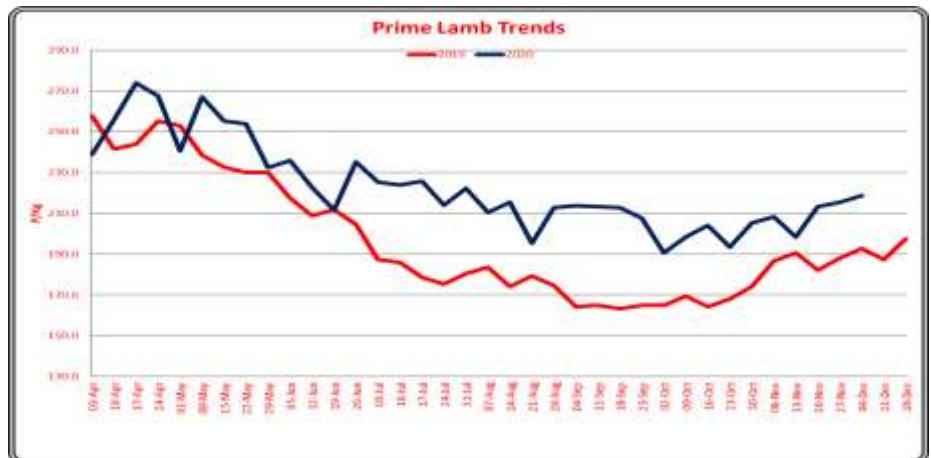
PRIME LAMBS - 2184

A stronger entry of lambs, that were well received and wanted resulting in an SQQ of 219p/kg soaring to 250p/kg for a pen of 38kg from W L Jerman, The Wern. Again the leaner they were the better they were with any amount of those 30kg to 42kg lambs 225p/kg to 240p/kg. Those export type lambs an excellent trade with the 32 - 39kg lambs averaging no less than 224p/kg. The top 20 prices all over 231p/kg. The heavies also stronger with nice pens of 46kg to 48kg making £98 to £100. The very heavies topped at £110/head for 60kg from L E Lloyd & Sons and others from £100 to £106.50. All in all an excellent trade and more could have been sold on the trade.

A larger entry this week with several vendors travelling a long distance to sell sheep at Hereford. Best continentals as ever the highlights of the day, with the highest price for some time of £156, plenty of Texel and Charollais from £117 to £136. Mules as easy to sell as anything with big and heavy to £94.50, several better pens from £80 to £85. Good show of Suffolk sheep finding similar prices i.e. proper pens from £100 to £112 with not much under £80. Hill breeds thinner on the ground with big Cheviots over £70, Welsh and Speckle close to £60. Several men shopping for grazing ewes, these generally from £60 to £80. Not the quality of rams this week but still best around £100 to a top of £113, overall average up £6 to £73.86.

Potential purchasers MUST REGISTER with Hereford Market Auctioneers Ltd prior to the sale and again upon entry to the market Tel: 01432 761882, email: hma@herefordmarket.com, website www.herefordmarket.co.uk or bma@builthmarketauctioneers.com

Purchaser spaces will be limited in the sale ring therefore only ONE person per business will be allowed entry to the sale ring.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times.

To facilitate the Test and Trace system, all customers/visitors will be required to sign into the market. This process will include a declaration that they have not been in contact with anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19, nor are displaying symptoms personally.
