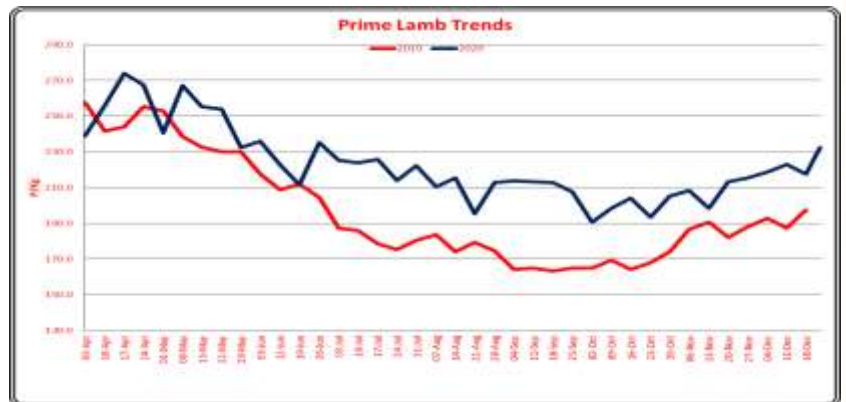
On a week where some deadweight firms used any excuse and took 60p/kg (dead) out of the lambs, the livestock markets bang an equivalent of at least 40p into them. There is no question, if the markets finish you might just as well sell every ewe on the farm! A super entry of over 2000 lambs sold to a fabulous trade with pen after pen of those handy 36-45kg selling in excess of 240p/kg up to 259p/kg for a pen of 44kg lambs from M/s Eckley, Ffordfawr that soared to £114/head. Top 20 prices all over 248p/kg with a pen of 39kg soaring to £101/head! Again the leaner they were the dearer they were. The heavies also much sharper with a pen of 53kg from M/s L & D Morgan topping at £114/head. The top 20 prices all over £108/head and all in excess of 44kg! An overall SQQ of 232p/kg achieved.

Potential purchasers MUST REGISTER with Hereford Market Auctioneers Ltd prior to the sale and again upon entry to the market Tel: 01432 761882, email: hma@herefordmarket.com, website www.herefordmarket.co.uk or bma@builthmarketauctioneers.com

Purchaser spaces will be limited in the sale ring therefore only ONE person per business will be allowed entry to the sale ring.

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

One metre-plus social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times.

To facilitate the Test and Trace system, all customers/visitors will be required to sign into the market. This process will include a declaration that they have not been in contact with anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19, nor are displaying symptoms personally.
