All weights in superb demand with those 36kg to 44kg a serious go, all 250p/kg plus, in fact the top 20 prices were all 263p/kg plus. Lightweights also a phenomenal trade with 36kg to 267p/kg and 28.5kg at 261p/kg and 32kg at 259p (£83). A fantastic trade throughout and more could have easily been sold on this trade.

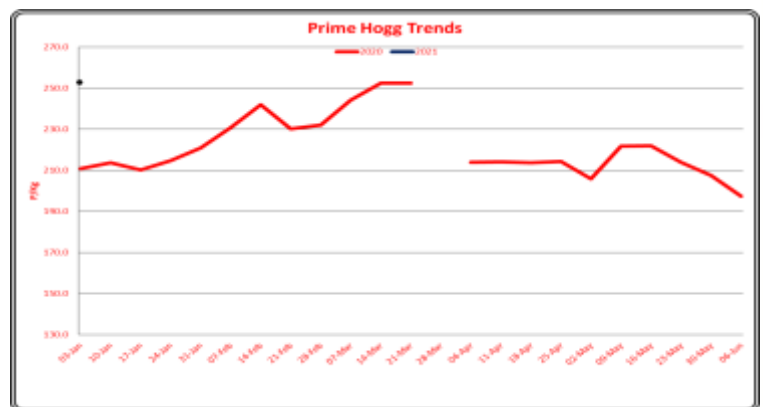

DROP AND GO POLICY FOR ALL VENDORS

No children under 16 years old will be able to attend the sales and this must be strictly adhered to as entry will be refused.

Pregnant ladies must not attend the sale.

Two metre social distancing must be observed.

Viewing will be regulated by a social distancing policy in the market and is to be permitted for registered buyers only.

Face coverings will be required in the sale ring and the yard at all times. Gloves are recommended.
