
SPRING LAMBS - 1957

SPRING LAMBS SQQ Average - 319.63p/kg <u> Auctioneer - Matthew Nicholls</u>

This is what you call a proper Bonanza!! This mornings trade would be 20p to 30p/kg dearer than anywhere recorded yesterday resulting in an average of 320p/kg up to 358p/kg for a pen of 40.5kg that flew to £145/hd for lambs from W L Jerman & Sons, Wern Farm. Another pen of 36.5kg from the same stable selling to £126/hd or 345p/kg. Top 20 pens all over 336p/kg. All weights wanted, again with a slight premium on the tups, any amount of those 41kg types trading between £132 to £140/hd. The heavies also much faster sailing to £178 for 58kg from Messrs Johnson, others to £170, £163, £162, £160.50, £160 etc.

A flyer from start to finish, an absolutely cracking trade in readiness for the Qurbani!


PRIME HOGGS

Average - 254.2p/kg

Still plenty of life in the hoggs, quality would be more mixed with fewer better runs of hoggs presented, a larger percentage being Hill types this week. Well meated heavier hoggs still remain the easiest sold with several penfuls trading £120 - £135. Heavier hoggs topped at £164 others from £135 - £152.50. Better bred hoggs still 265p - 285p/kg, with hoggs topping at 298p/kg.

Lighter hoggs remaining harder work than the heavier types, 200p - 240p/kg depending on meat and breed. Several hill hoggs these if meat would be respectable from £75 - £90. Plainer hoggs meeting much steadier demand. The time is nearly all over for the hoggs, only weight and meat will be required.

Smaller entry but much improved trade, with all buyers much more animated and competitive. Not many 'posh' sheep about but a good solid trade on big meaty crossbreds from $\pounds 120 - \pounds 150$. Once again lean Suffolk ewes fitted everyone's bill between $\pounds 90 - \pounds 117$.

Easiest to sell of all were the 'festival' sheep, Welsh speckle and Cheviots with all the strength over £100, Cheviots to £119.50, Beulah's to £121 and bunches from £80 - £95. Mule ewes, the fatter the better, topping at £140.

Rams okay too, better examples from $\pounds 130 - \pounds 150$. Our thanks to the vendors who presented their sheep shorn - it is definitely an advantage when selling them. Overall average was up £18 on the week.

The festival begins next Tuesday, please feel free to check with Rob Meadmore or Phil Jones about expected demand.
