SPRING LAMBS - 1957



The first thing to say is that the store market is on a Tuesday and is open and ready for business. There are far too many lean lambs coming forward in the fat section which severely hampers the overall trade.

Yes, the trade is falling back but at least when we hit some meated lambs there were plenty bidding for them! A pen of 38kg topped at £118/hd or 311p/kg for a pen from Messrs W L Jerman & Sons, The Wern. The top 12 pens of 41kg plus weights were all over 280p/kg and the top 30 pens all over 270p/kg. A good run of 45kg from Messrs K J Williams and Piggott topped at £125.80/hd and a pen of 44kg from Messrs W G Llewellyn made £125.50/hd. Plenty at this weight trading from £120 to £125/hd. The lighter weights harder work but the meat would be 260p to 270p/kg. The heavies in greatest demand albeit less than previous weeks topping at £148/hd for a pen of 56kg from Messrs T Davies, others at £143, £140 (twice) £139.50 etc.

More purebreds forward and all well rewarded with a top price of £187 and plenty between £156 and £172. Thick, meaty Suffolks between £130 and £163, with Texels slightly less. Leaner and lighter all around £100, with only very plain ewes from £60 to £80. Mules to £132, big bunches with meat and weight from £110 to £125. Leaner and grazing types from £70 to £90. No real heavy hitters in the hill breds, top of £96. Plenty of best Welsh ewes from £75 to £90. Rams to £140 (twice), average £112.
