1,756 TOTAL SHEEP

PRIME LAMBS – 1,117

A reduced entry on the week down to the change of day and lacklustre demand at the start of the week. Trade was much sharper than anticipated resulting in a market average of 250p/kg.

Weight and meat again highly sought after however the 41kg to 45kg lambs making the most per kilo. No end trading 260p/kg plus rattling to 269p/kg from ME Thomas & Son, Caerau for lambs weighing 44kg (£118.50). Heavier lambs to £140 twice with a super pen of 53kg lambs from the Gayther Family, Cwmygaist sailing to £137.20. Lambs weighing 47kg and up generally all £120 plus with several £125 to £140.

Well-bred handy weights 250p/kg to 271p/kg topped by Powell Bros, Blaenbwch for 34kg lambs at £92. Hill bred types 230p/kg to 250p/kg depending on meat with firms far more active on these sorts. Light section made up of predominantly light hill lambs and topping 266p/kg from M Griffiths, Nanty. Very light and harder bred lambs 215p/kg to 230p/kg and easier sold than in previous Fridays.

A pleasing entry given the change of day with the stronger ewes a proper trade. Thirteen Texel bred ewes to £147 from G Morgan, Bronglyn. Charollais £142 and Suffolk cross to £136.50. Mules to £127.50 and Cheviots to £109. Top 9 prices all £127 and up. Several crossbred ewes and Mules in excess of £110, half meated sorts £80 to £95.

Hill ewes to £109 from JS & MS Kinsey, Box Farm with several £80 to £90. Smaller types with either meat or potential £50 to £70. Large show of very small and plain ewes which has pulled the average back with these £25 to £40 unless very poor.

Overall average £73.86
