## **SECOND SPECIAL SALE OF EWE LAMBS - 6646**

Another outstanding entry for the second multi-breed ewe lamb sale, a large crowd of purchasers flocking to Hereford attracted by the large entry and quality on offer.

Purchasers were not disappointed with vendors turning out another superb display of ewe lambs. Trade carried on from the first sale with all shapes and sizes keenly contested and another outstanding trade prevailed.

Pedigree Texel ewe lambs topping the day at £380 and £240, both from M/s R M & G L Watkins, Upper Cwm Farm. Pure Charollais to £210 and £175 from M/s T & C Dyke.

In the commercial ewe lambs the top prices dominated by Texel x Mules with £162 hit 3 times, twice by M/s M J & N E Samuel and from M/s E G C Davies & Co, M/s V E Lewis & Son (£161) and M/s J L & K H Nixon (£160). The strongest, smartest Texels trading from £145-£160, with smaller smart headed Texel x Mules nearly all £130-£145 with plenty either side of £140. Only the smaller poorer headed ewe lambs under £120.

Suffolk x Mules topping at £157 twice from M/s D E & C E Davies, Blaenyresgair. Others to £154 from the same home, with Mrs M Hughes also to £155. M/s E J & D E Evans, Glanedw to £152 with M/s S Williams & Son to £152. Plenty of the strongest Suffolk x Mules trading £140 to £150.

The smart headed running lambs trading from £130-£140 and looking a real price. Smaller sorts from £115-£125 with nearly all finding customers. Some excellent runs of running Suffolk x Mules with large consignments from J P & J A Davies, S I Rogers and K O Rogers all seeing plenty of lambs in the £130s. Welsh Mule ewe lambs topping at £155 from M/s E Jones, Brynmelyn, T & C Dyke to £155. M/s Hamer, Trinnant to £151 and M/s K Williams to £150. The strongest smart headed white Mules from £135-£145. Smaller sorts all from £115-£130, with M/s Bufton, Eaglestone selling their large run to £136, £132 twice and £130. North Country Cheviot ewe lambs to £110, £102 and £100.

An excellent clearance with only a handful unsold.

## STORE LAMBS - 2026

#### <u>Auctioneer - Greg Christopher</u>

A smaller show of stores due in part to the ewe lamb sale however the dearest trade witnessed this autumn with buying power for 5000 plus lambs, all types taking a good jump on the week with over 800 lambs trading £100 plus.

Strength topping at £120 and £118 with 50 Suffolk x lambs to £114, 54 Texels to £110.50 and plenty of stronger lambs £105-£110. 100 Suffolk x lambs to £104 - over 800 lambs trading £100 plus.

A good show of farming lambs - these nearly all £90-£100, only a few plainer types late £80's.

The well bred medium keep lambs from £78-£85 with plenty trading in the £80's. A few smaller hill types and backward lambs - these from £50-£65 depending on strength and potential.

Ram lambs to £120, others to £114. 60 Texel x to £106.50, strength £94-£102, farming sorts £80-£90. Smaller and hill types in the £70's with more life to the ram lambs this week.

6000 plus lambs will now be required each week as more seasonal purchasers enquire for store lambs.

#### **BREEDING EWES - 1224**

#### **Auctioneer - Rory Matthews**

A very pleasing number of ewes for mid-October with hill ewes now the large majority. Quality starting to dwindle which is to be expected this late in the season with demand for ewes as strong as they have been all autumn.

Texel cross yearling ewes to £212 and £202 for two very respectable pens from Ken Jones, Cornel with Welsh Mules to £178 and Suffolk cross to £175. Several smaller yet well put together yearling ewes trading £150 to £170, with leaner types some way off tupping generally £130 to £145. Coloured Mule 3's & 4's to £165 from M/s Collard, Ashfield Farm, with older Suffolks to £155 and North Country Mules to £152, both from HC Yarnold. Leaner types a stickier trade as tupping time approaches however finding plenty of customers at a level.

A lovely run of much fancied Welsh/Cheviot ewes from MR & GD Davies, Penybanc saw yearlings to £155, 2's & 3's to £160 and full mouthed to £140. Several stronger full and broken mouthed Mule, Welsh and Cheviot ewes £100 to £115 for the stronger end. Smaller hill types £70 to £95 with more tired-looking brokers mostly £50 to £65. Plain Welsh yearlings either side of £100 depending on strength. JP Sevenoaks' run of flock aged Cheviots and Welsh saw a top of £142 with others cashed at £135 and £132.
