Other best yearlings to £205, £202 twice and £200 with plenty of business done in the £190's for both coloured's and whites. Smaller ewes looking very well sold in the £160 to £185 bracket. A handful of harder bred types in the £150's, with only leaner ewes under £150.

An excellent show of Mule ewe lambs for the second sale was embraced by a huge crowd of purchasers as the Welsh Mule popularity very much in favour at present. A complete opposite to second sales last year with keep plentiful, strong yearling trade and considerably less numbers in the association second sales, with Hereford being 1200 lambs less on the year.

A superb trade throughout the sale with all shapes and sizes in demand. The smaller the lamb the dearer it looked, with today's trade certainly giving uplands shepherds encouragement to continue with hill ewes to breed Welsh Mules.

Sale topped at £202 for smart coloured Mules from Mr E H Bennett, other coloured Mules to £190 from M/s R G & B M Jones, Ty Mawr, M/s D E & G Davies & Son, Llwynpiod to £188,and Mr D E Thomas, Grofft to £185. Several stronger smarter lambs all £160 to £180 for both coloured and white faced although the coloured Mules just having the edge. The stronger lambs very easy to sell and would be every bit as dear as the first sale.

The strongest running lambs trading £140 - £155 with plenty either side of £150. Customers willing to pay for the smart sorts.

The smaller running lambs looked a tremendous trade with these nearly all £125 - £140, only a few small harder bred Mules £115 - £125 with no lambs sold under £110. A complete clearance throughout with the lambs averaging a phenomenal £140.15, a huge rise of £36/head on the year.
