PRIME LAMBS – 1,828

A few less about however trade sharp for the heavier well fleshed lambs, lighter lambs and hill lambs slightly easier on the week. All firms active and looking to source lambs for Monday morning, with well meated lambs becoming harder to find as the continued weather really getting into some sheep. Heavy lambs topping at £150 70.5kg from Mr A J Abberley, JS & MS Kinsey to £145 and £140 with Messrs Jones, Ty-Cerrig to £139.50.

Several pens from £130-£139 for the smarter 52kg plus lambs. Over 250 heavier Mule lambs this week these 50-54kg trading £120-£127. Well fleshed 45-48kg trading £120-£128, with several pens of the better lambs 260p/kg plus. Better export lambs 40-44kg trading 260-270p/kg with the smartest sorts to 281p/kg from JS & MS Kinsey 44.5kg-£125.

Just over 600 lighter lambs with quality more mixed, several 25-28kg Hill lambs only just graded and plenty lean enough. Cross-bred types continue to be good to sell from 250-270p/kg topping at 304 and 303p/kg both from W P Harley for smart Texel cross lambs 35.5kg and 30kg, other better crossbred lambs 280-290p/kg. Light Hill lambs from 215-235p/kg depending on weight and meat, the 30kg plus hill lambs easiest sold this week, hill lambs from £57-£75/head depending on weight and meat

Overall average for all lambs £104.47/head.

A few less ewes forward which is just starting to happen in other centres, trade would also be slightly dearer to good, with good competition throughout.

Best Texel ewes to £154 from TGP Samuel, others to £133 from the same home. Other better cross-bred ewes from £90 to £124. Several ewes over £100, strong Mules remaining slightly harder work with several pens of good Mules from £78-£90. Cheviots to £94, other better hill ewes in the £60's and early £70's.

Smaller and leaner hill ewes from $\pm 45 - \pm 60$ depending on frame and potential. The very small and hardy hill ewes trading from $\pm 20-\pm 40$ depending on frame and meat.

A selection of Rams this week, trade good for these with a bunch of 15 Hardy Speckles to £95, Texel cross Rams to £134, £121 and £120. Other better cross-bred Rams £85-£115. Hill Rams from £55-£80.
