All the well made calves looking a good trade and no less on the week. Several middling sorts, mostly Blue bulls and heifers, trading $\pounds170-\pounds260$ depending on potential. The medium to smaller calves would be just slightly less on the week. Several Angus calves in, these up to $\pounds280$. Smaller sorts $\pounds100-\pounds150$.

Friesian bull calf trade improving again this week, these up to ± 100 , with several $\pm 50-\pm 75$.
