

Just a nice entry of 2600 lambs sold to a very buoyant trade resulting in an SQQ 270.19p/kg up to 307p/kg for 35kg that flew to £107.50/hd, plenty of lambs 280p/kg to 300p/kg. All weights easily sold providing they were meat with 48kg sailing to £147/hd or 306p/kg. The 43kg to 45kg better export types trading from £120 to £128.50/hd. The very heavies an excellent trade with a pen of 51kg topping at £155/hd with a pen of 60kg topping the market at £165/hd, others at £162, £160, £159 etc. A super run of 172 lambs averaging 53kg averaged £144/hd.

A very pleasing entry sold to a marvelous trade.

An insufficient entry, albeit in line with the rest of the country, with again more grazers than meated sheep forward. A feature of the day was a reduction sale on behalf of Robin Slade of Beltex ewes selling to a top of £144, others at £136 and £127. Any amount of the better made sheep between £132 and £148. As mentioned plenty of grazers in the mix, better end £75 to £85, smaller £68 to £72.50. Rams a decent shout topping at £190 others between £120 and £143.

Overall average up £11 at £86.29 reflecting fresh purchasers in attendance and sharp competition throughout.

Probably the easiest commodity to sell at the moment is goats with a top price of £170 and an average of £145.

New Veterinary Attestation rule for farmers to be introduced on 13th December

Changes in legislation, as from 13th December 2023, will require all producers selling livestock for slaughter to have had an annual farm veterinary visit to allow their animals, and/or part of any animal, to be exported out of the UK. The purpose of the new rule is to comply with EU export requirements to verify the absence of notifiable disease and provide general advice on farm biosecurity.

Why is this changing?

The Statutory Health Attestation is required from the 13 December 2023 to certify exports of POAO (Products of Animal Origin) to the EU. The EHCs (Export Health Certificates) require that the animals' farm of origin has undergone regular visits by a veterinary surgeon.

What do producers need to do?

Producers will be required to obtain a signed declaration from their vet that the visit has taken place.

The LAA recommends that producers take steps now to obtain a signed declaration from their vet.

This should be signed and completed by the farm vet.

Obtaining a signed veterinary attestation must be done at least once over a 12-month period and can be combined with any other routine veterinary visit, including government supported initiatives such as the Animal Health and Welfare Pathway in England.

Farmers and vets must keep a copy of their completed declarations and the "unique reference number" created, for their records and to provide to their livestock auction market or meat processor.

It is expected that the sheep movement document will be updated to include a declaration that a visit has taken place, with additional space to include the "unique reference number" – We will confirm this once Defra have signed the process off. Farms that are part of qualifying assurance schemes do not need to complete the veterinary declaration. Membership of these farm assurance schemes is accepted as evidence that a premises of origin meets the requirement for regular health visits from a vet. The qualifying schemes are:

- Annual health and welfare review (England only)
- Quality Meat Scotland (QMS)
- Farm Assured Welsh Livestock Beef and Lamb Scheme (FAWL) (Welsh Lamb and Beef Producers Ltd (WLBP))
- Red Tractor

Farmer declarations can be used until 13th December.
