A smaller show on the week with several lambs not forward and farmers taking advantage of two consecutive dry days. Trade very strong throughout with all lambs keenly bid for. Smaller and medium keep lambs a shader dearer with the farming lambs a stand-on trade.

Strength not too plentiful and not quite as dear, lambs to £120, £117 and £114.50 twice. Other stronger lambs £105-£112.

A very good show of farming lambs although more Mule wethers and Romney x lambs this week. A very competitive ringside of customers meaning all lambs selling to advantage. The better farming lambs $\pounds 94 \cdot \pounds 104$. Several large bunches of the best lambs $\pounds 100 \cdot \pounds 103$. A super run of 100 Texels from one farm to average $\pounds 103.75$. Smart Texels and Beltex not forward in huge numbers or size but regularly from $\pounds 88 \cdot \pounds 100$ for medium sorts.

The next step down in the farming lambs £88-£94, with plenty £91-£93. A larger selection of Mule wethers - these to £96.50, other large bunches of Mules to £93.50 & £92, smaller sorts £82-£88, strong Romney x lambs to £96, others to £86.50 with several £77-£84 for longer keeping sorts.

Medium keep lambs remained easy to sell with the well bred lambs £84-£89 and numerous bunches £87-£89. Plainer sorts from £80-£84 depending on potential.

Longer keep lambs remarkably good to sell considering the ground conditions. Better bred lambs regularly from £68-£78 with plenty of business being done £72-£76. Harder bred longer term lambs to include some smaller hill cross lambs from £62-£72. Very small from £50-£60. A fair few less ram lambs this week with just over 1100. In this several hill types and longer term ram lambs, strength short on the ground with these from £97-£107 topping at £114.50. Several farming ram lambs £88-£96 for the better bred sorts. Strong hill lambs £80-£88 with longer term sorts from £70-£84. Very few under £70, only a few smaller hill types.




