

STORE LAMBS - 7291

A larger entry on the week with a tremendous show of lambs a credit to all vendors, the sheep benefitting from 2 consecutive dry days. A busy, albeit slightly smaller ringside of purchasers present and all very active for numbers, led to another super trade throughout.

Trade sharper for all sorts with the exception of some longer term lambs, these very similar, current weather conditions obviously hampering this section.

Strongest lambs topped at £137, £132.50, £124.50. Several pens of the strongest £110 to £118, with 50 Suffolk x Mules to £114. Plenty of large bunches £105 to £110.

A superb show of farming lambs with the strongest & smartest sorts all trading £98 to £108 with over 1550 lambs trading over £100.

The next step down but still well bred lambs from £90 to £97, to include several Suffolk x lambs and the smaller Texels. Smart Texels remained very easy to sell, with the smart sorts £95 to £108, no end of these best lambs £102 to £108.

Medium lambs including Mules & Cheviots seeing Mules to £92, other stronger Mules £86 to £90, smaller farming types £77 to £84.50. The best Cheviots well in the £80's, likewise several Romney x lambs from £70 to £90 depending on frame and condition. Well bred medium keep lambs from £85 to £90, with the next notch down in the early £80's.

Longer term lambs seeing the better bred from £65 to £75, plainer and harder bred lambs from £60 to £72 depending on strength , very few lambs under £55.

A few less Ram lambs this week, the strength and meat trading £96 to £110, very strong £110 plus.

Farming types to include several Mules and the strongest Hill ram lambs from £85 to £95, smaller types £74 to £82, with smaller Hill ram lambs and plain sorts from £65 to £75.

Ewe numbers tightening fast now as the season draws to a close.

Only a handful of In-lambers again with these flying to £380 for flock aged Pure Suffolks, scanned twins and due on the 8th January, from Mr. P Hope and looking tremendously well sold.

Numerous runs of smaller cross bred ewes present with several having already been running with the ram. Stronger ewes trading £118 to £130 for Charollais, Texel, Suffolk and Mules. Leaner types £100 to £108 with only very plain ewes of these types not clearing the £100 barrier. Broken mouthed Mules to £84 and £80 with Cheviots to £72 three times and Scottish black face to £70.

In conclusion another pleasing trade. Still plenty of interest in the breeding ewes and the in-lamber section starting to take shape. Please contact Rory or Rob to discuss marketing or purchasing breeding ewes.
