STEERS & HEIFERS - 493

An excellent show of cattle for the time of year both in terms of numbers and quality. Some exceptional runs of suckler bred cattle forward. The trade can only be described as brisk and as one buyer described it as "a trade to tame lions". Several fresh buyers in attendance in addition to our regulars which ensured this buoyant trade.

These strongest and best Continental types were really rocking and rolling at one time. The steers topped at a serious £1960/head for a 715kg Charollais steer from Messrs J M Jones & Son, The Bwlchau who had a superb entry of cattle forward to average £1685/ head, which were mostly Angus x by named sires. The top steers all trading over £1700/ head.

The heifers very much the same topping at £1880 for a 32 month old Angus x heifer from A D & K J Williams, Blaencurdy.

The steers topped at 333p/kg for a 450kg Limousin from D L & J A Price, Quarry Hill who had a lovely run of 18 steers and heifers forward. Some of the lightest cattle in this run, by far the dearest with plenty of demand for those 350kg steers and heifers.

Very similar story with the heifers topping at 333p/kg for a 460kg Limousin heifer from M G & E Jones, Caeronen, another Limousin heifer from Messrs J Herdman & Son, New House close behind at 332p/kg for a 19 months, 455kg Limousin that made £1510/head. An exceptional run of suckler heifers and steers that averaged 312.5p/kg or £1503/head up to £1755/head for a 550kg Limousin steer.

The strength very easily placed with an entry from J G Herring, with an average weight of 550kg levelling at £1653/head up to £1735, a run of Blues and Charollais from G & B Williams, Blaenglynolwyn averaging £1546/head up to £1760/head.

The longer feeding type cattle pounds dearer than last sale, especially some of those native bred types. A run of 22 Angus x steers and heifers from P & D Jones, Redborough sparked strong interest topping at £1470/head and averaging £1234/head for an entry averaging 454kg.

A significant variation of cattle forward today with some very plain and smaller sorts throughout the catalogue.


Several runs of well fed dairy bred cattle with these as easy to sell as anything. Messrs C E & L Lawrence, Tynllan seeing Blue x bullocks to £1595, Blondes to £1540 and Limousin x to £1740. Several Blue x types anywhere from £1200 to £1400 for the stronger, leaner and smaller types from £900 to £1100 for what were mostly heifers.

Herefords to £1700 for some very strong steers from E S Hughes, Lower Bilfield. Several Herefords from £1100 to £1380 to include steers and heifers. Smaller native cattle anywhere from £700 to £1000 and far easier sold than in November. Older sorts not heavy weighing proving the hardest sold as is to be expected. Handful of very small plainer types £500 to £650.

FEEDING BULLS - 120

A much larger show of feeding bulls with quality much improved and some very good runs of bulls for December. Best bulls sailing to £1950 (610kg) from T W Price & Morgan, Tyrosser, others to £1885 (640kg) from R W & C S Richards, 16mths Charolais bulls to £1605, with other smart 10-13month bulls trading £1400 - £1550. Several bulls 300p/kg plus today topping at 324p/kg, 450kg, £1460 from T W Roberts & Son, S G Morris to 322p/kg, 390kg, £1255, several bulls 305p - 320p/kg.

Farming bulls from £1220 - £1450 with in-spec and well farmed and fleshed bulls very good to sell.

Smart younger bulls also a sharp trade and the best of these £1050 - £1180 (280p - 300p/kg), smaller and store types from £850 - £1000. Some very plain older types £350 - £500, with older bulls with condition trading £1100 - £1450 depending on breed and size and meeting fierce competition.

A very varied sample of breeding cattle with very little quality forward. Cows and calves topped at £1820 for a Blue x cow and heifer calf. Others to £1280, older outfits to £1120 and £1080. A run of in-calf Blue and Limousin cows, aged, to £1180, £1100 twice, £1090, with plain types £750 - £1000.

Next sale to include 90 tremendous continental in-calf cows from Upper Court.

BARREN COWS - 75

A much larger entry of cows with an increased ringside of customers. Trade would be improved especially the stronger meated and better shaped cows. Still several small and very plain types and this is reflected by the average.

Best cows to £1710 from S Lloyd, other smart Limousin cows to £1540 (770kg) from R W & C S Richards, W L Jerman to £1525, other stronger meated cows trading from £1250 - £1485. Cows topped at 221p/kg from C E & L Lawrence, Tynllan with other better cows 185p -207p/kg with more cows over 200p/kg. The stronger feeding cows dearer these £1050 - £1300 depending on potential, condition and frame. Plainer stronger cows from £900 - £1050, with smaller plain cows from £500 - £750. Some very small cold types £300 - £500.
