

# BUILTH MARKET REPORT FRIDAY 16<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2024

### PRIME HOGGS – 1,902

Top price £191.00 for hogas grading 63kg

A good show in terms of numbers and far greater than we expected to see, a large proportion being hill bred and mules, which makes the overall average of 316.4p/kg an even more remarkable achievement. Trade for all weights exceptional with all weights and breeds in huge demand. Heavy hoggs climbing to £191 (63kg) twice from Messrs G Jones & Co, others to £184.50, £182 and £180 twice. Commercial heavies trading £155-£170.50 with several trading £160 plus with the top 20 pens over £160. Heavy Welsh to £165, heavy Mules to £160, with Speckles to £155. Well fed Ram hoggs continue to be hotly contested with smarter types 320-330p/kg £148-£157, best to £164 (50.5kg).

A J Abberley showing another excellent run of fed hoggs with their best to 338p/kg 46kg £155.50 and 45kg £152. Well fed Welsh and Cheviots also in excellent demand trading 310-320p/kg for the right sorts and generally £100 over their weight.

Over 750 lightweight hoggs, these the trade of the day, with the 32-39kg averaging 323p/kg to include a vast proportion of hill types. Smarter cross-breds topped at 352p/kg 33.5kg £117.80 for smart Texel's from Mr R Parry, other 36.5kg and 37kg to 339p/kg £125.50 and £123.80. Several pens 330p/kg plus with the next step down 310-325p/kg.

Hill types following the cross-breds and a superb trade with a good run of fed Welsh hoggs from Messrs Davies, Wernhalog with 36,5kg £116, 33kg £106 and 31.5kg £100.50. Several hill hoggs 30kg plus trading 310-320p/kg. Demand from 24kg upwards with nearly all hoggs 285p/kg plus.

More hoggs are required to meet this current demand.
