What an unbelievable day in the suckled calf ring! Vendors must be congratulated on quality of stock presented today at Hereford. A packed house with purchasers present from a wide area with several leaving empty handed or short of requirements.

The day certainly started off with a bang! An outstanding entry of 110 bulls with buyers keen to get numbers bought. Top price going to Werfa farm, Glamorgan with a 9 month old Lim bull, 450kg thundering to £1530. Others similar weight from the same home £1525 & £1520.

Mr TD Pearson's Limousin bulls 382kg, £1480 (386p/kg!). M/s W L Jerman & Son with a cracking run of Limousin bulls, 390kg rocketing to £1440. Another grand run, this time 9 month old Charolais x bulls from Mr J E G Price Ddulley bank, 412kg to £1360 (329p/kg). Others from the same home all trading around 320-330p/kg. Any amount of the better bred bulls trading £1200-£1400 and 310-350p/kg.

Smaller, plainer types looking very well sold, these trading from £850-£1000, all around the 270p-300p/kg mark.

OVERALL BULL AVERAGE 306p/kg

Top price steer of £1640 for an outstanding blue from M/s L J & G V Rea, Middlewick farm, weighing 430kg (381p/kg). Other magnificent cattle from the same home £1550, £1500 & £1450, All 362p-381p/kg. M/s D E & S J Cheacker with a Limousin steer, 11 months, 405kg storming to £1580 (390p/kg). Others from same farm to £1545.

All those best steers sold with ease, with plenty of purchasers looking to source these best types. M/s WP JM & NP Pritchard with a fantastic run of steers reaching £1520 for a well made 10 month Limousin (362p/kg). Also from the same home a shapely 345kg steer making £1430 - 414p/kg, simply unbelievable! Again too many to mention but all these best steers trading from 350-380p/kg.

OVERALL STEER AVERAGE 324p/kg

Into the heifers top price of £1550 for a 395kg Limousin (392pkg) from Mr R W Lloyd. Others from the same home £1450, £1410 & £1320. These all trading around that 365-392p/kg. M/s A A & M G Wozencraft with a tremendous shaped 320kg 9month old Limousin heifer accelerating to £1320 (412p/kg). A quality run of heifers from M/s P Jones & Co, up to £1300 for a bunch of 5. All these best heifers trading from 350-412p/kg.
