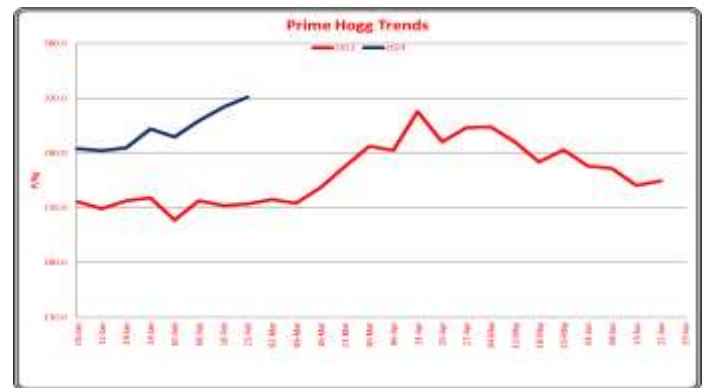
1175 hoggets = a trade that just keeps getting dearer with an SQQ of 331p/kg sailing to 371p/kg for a pen of 39kg that reached £144.50/hd. The lighter they were the dearer they were with the under 30kg hoggs averaging a staggering 343p/kg, a pen of 31.5kg selling to 356p/kg look a phenomenal trade as did a pen of 30kg that rocketed to 360p/kg or £108/hd.

Any amount of pens trading in excess of 340p/kg with 20 pens all over 345p/kg. The nice meated 45kg selling to £161/hd. The super heavy hoggs dearer again with 71kg thundering to £191/hd, others at £189.50 (twice), £188, £180, £179 etc.

In general not the show of hoggs with more hill breeds and several clear up hoggs however all hoggs averaging £142.39- more hoggs are required each week.

A larger show of ewes and a welcome jump with ewes £10-£20 dearer throughout. A mixed show of ewes with several smaller hill ewes, all types very good to sell, although strongest ewes seeing the largest increase in value.

Very few pure ewes with strong Texel x ewes to £210, other good Texel x ewes £160 to £195, Suffolk x Mules to £166, several pens £145 to £160. Lean Suffolk & Texel x ewes £125 to £145, with far more business being done £130 to £140.

A good run of strong Aberfield x Romney ewes travelled looked very well sold with plenty of pens £130 to £140, next step down £115 to £125.

Mules seeing the strongest ewes in the £130's, several £115 to £125, best topping at £142, smaller Mules £95 to £110.

Strong Welsh & Cheviots over £100, several better Hill ewes £85 to £95, leaner types £70 to £80 with the small ewes £50 to £65 and look the dearest, very few ewes under £40.

Rams to £146, although very few good crossbred rams, leaner types £90 to £120.
