A larger show of hoggs with livestock markets leaving deadweight firms well off the pace as demand far outstripping current supply with numbers short, vendors please Sell Live to Thrive!!! At these levels to maximise returns continue supporting live auctions.

Simply unreal competition and demand for all weights leading to a sensational overall Average of 313p/kg with plenty of Hill hoggs in all weight ranges.

Heavy hoggs to £175, £169, £168 and £165 twice. 50kg plus trading £150-£160 to include Hill types and Mules, with Heavy Mules to £160, several pens £145-£150.

Ram hoggs again superb to sell with plenty trading 310-320p/kg to include Welsh and Cheviots provided they were good meat. Continental types seeing 44.5kg and 45kg £150 from Messrs Abberley, the best types over 330p/kg- more wanted each week to satisfy demand.

Export weight hoggs trading 305-315p for well bred hoggs, the smarter end them 320-335p topping at 336p x 2 with 40.5kg £136 from Messrs Rees and PW Jones 41.5kg £139.50. Another grand run from Cwmdulas seeing the best to 332p/kg 45.5kg £151 several pens £144- £147. Mules and Hill types from 290-300p depending on meat.

Over 650 Lightweight hoggs these possibly the trade of the day, the majority Hill types, crossbred 32-37kg seeing no end trade 305-315p, topping at 352p/kg 32kg £112.50, plenty of 34-36kg hoggs £110-£120. Hill hoggs equally as dear with demand from 24kg upwards with plenty of Hill types 300p/kg plus 32kg Cheviots £101.20, with 29kg £94.50, others nearly all 280p plus.

Best ewes another fantastic trade seeing Pure Texels to £225 from M/s CD Gayther & Son, Cwmygaist. Other pure types to £196 & £176 from DG Davies, Cwmgwillim with a trio from Price & Morgan, Tyrosser to £189. Several stronger types £133 to £146 with the best of the Mules in the £100 to £108 bracket. No-end of mules trading £85 to £98.

Hill ewes perhaps a touch easier on last Friday however still a marked improvement on what we became accustomed to in the back end of 2023. Best Welsh and Speckles clearing the £90 barrier with several hill ewes £70 to £85 to include Eppynt types.

Small meated and framed leaner ewes anywhere from £50 to £70. Small hardy sorts £35 to £48 unless very small or plain, more of these about and generally from £25 and into the low £30's. Cull rams less plentiful and upto £127.

Overall averaged £63.60
