REPORT 724 STORE CATTLE

THURSDAY 21st MARCH 2024

An incredible trade throughout and without doubt some cattle would be £150/head dearer than last sale. The fat might be quoted as being less but it certainly wasn't reflected in the ring today which was a surprise to many, with several expecting to see the cattle less money.

Certainly less strength about today but those forward were serious! A 590kg Limousin from M/s H J W Hammond & Son, Tygwyn flew to £1910/head, another bunch of four Charolais at 540kg from M/s T E Walters & Son made £1885/head. The heifers just as dear, selling up to £1730/head for a pair from M/s G A Davies & Son, Esgairmoel. Several stronger cattle trading £1600-£1800 for both steers and heifers.

The smaller, farming types looking some of the dearest sold with 3 Charolais steers (12 months) topping at 361p/kg for 340kg from M/s A M Price, Llwynpenderi. A smart 11 month old 470kg steer sailed to £1695/head or 360.5p/kg from Mr A D Albutt, who had a superb entry of cattle.

Some good runs forward with 51 cattle from M/s Walters averaging 316p/kg or an impressive £1531/head. Another run of 30 quality Limousins mainly made up of heifers were an exceptional trade to average 318p/kg or £1540/head.

The stronger farming cattle looked the stronger trade of the day in places, cattle with shape and coat really ringing the bell. M/s M E Price & Son, Gwarallt selling 520kg steers to £1850 and others to £1735. M/s T E Walters, selling strong Charolais grazing types 540kg to £1885. M/s R S Preece & Sons' grand run of predominently heifers seeing plenty trading £1470 to £1560 topping at £1610 for the heifers, steers from the same farm to £1800 (500kg). Mr J D Powell selling eight Charolais x heifers 450kg to £1455. Several of these proper grazing types 320p-340p/kg.

Stronger dairy bred steers and heifers both remained another excellent trade with strong Simmental x steers to £1680 (590kg) from M/s N C Davies. Blues to £1670 (580kg) from M/s B G M & R V & B M Jones. Another good run of Blues and Angus steers from Mr K J Davies, Wernheulog - these to £1490 (540kg) for Blues, others to £1370, £1365 and £1355. Other native bred cattle seeing Angus to £1630 and £1580 both from M/s L & M Jones, several Hereford x steers from £1300-£1500, with younger native bred cattle from £1100-£1300.

The grazing/summering cattle very sought after with a run of younger sorts from M/s R I, G I & G Davies, Penlanlwyd trading well over £3/kg for cattle weighing between 360kg - 420kg. Cattle with frame and coat continue to be very easy to place, some fleshier cattle just starting to meet some slight resistance.

The overall sale averages to include all types speak for themselves with the steers and heifers averaging 290p/kg or £1357/head and 281p/kg or £1235/head respectively.

FEEDING BULLS - 158

Just over 150 bulls in this sale with some superb consignments but also a few more plainer & older sorts mixed throughout. Superb competition with the bulls no less than the last sale and the bulls averaging 292p/kg. Best Charolais bulls to £1760 (600kg) from M/s C & G Powell, Abercynithon, a super line up from M/s L M Howells & Son to £1625 (475kg) & £1615. M/s B G M & R V Jones, East Pilton to £1580 (510kg), M/s Watkins to £1540 & M/s Eynon to £1520.

A grand run of Simmental x bulls from M/s R I, G I & G Davies topping at £1515 (490kg) for a bunch of 5, others to £1505 (425kg) for another 5, well bred bulls all £1400 - £1500, with the next step down £1250 - £1380. Well shaped farming bulls to 350p/kg from M/s Davies, 410kg £1435, other smart bulls 325p - 345p/kg, with commercial bulls 300 - 320p/kg. Smart, younger bulls £1150 - £1300, again plenty 315p - 340p/kg, plainer bulls from £1000 - £1150, a few younger & plainer bulls from £850 - £980.

A few younger Angus bulls, these £900 - £1100, with a large bunch of 8 Angus bulls $465 \, \text{kg}$, £1360 from Llanbradoch Fawr Partnership. More bulls could have been sold to advantage.

Older bulls included Salers & Hereford x, these from £1200 - £1400 depending on frame and condition.

Several stronger meated cows from £1300-£1460, young Angus cows seeing Angus x at £1365 (540kg, 253p/kg). Other better cows 215p-240p/kg. Grazing cows from £1100-£1300 with these 200p-220p/kg. Leaner cows from £900-£1000, with a handful of very plain cows £750-£850. Hereford stock bulls to £1320 and £1000.
