
PRIME HOGGS - 1613

MARKET REPORTS WEDNESDAY 27th MARCH 2024

A good entry of hoggets sold to a blistering trade, on a par with two weeks ago, with the handy 39kg-45kg averaging 383p/kg up to a superb 453p/kg for 43kg from J Lewis, West Hills that made £195/hd. Another excellent run of 102 from Dunswater Farms averaging 405p/kg up to 449p/kg for 42.5kg that made £191/hd. Any amount of those best hoggs £4/kg plus, in fact 17 pens all in excess of this. The light hoggs looking some of the dearest with 30kg trading to £119/hd or 397p/kg, a pen of 34kg from Messrs Watkins making £136/hd or 400p/kg, and a pen of 38kg soaring to 418p/kg. The 46-47kg generally trading from £175 to £185, up to £194/hd. The heavies making a staggering £245/hd for 80kg hoggs, others at £236, £235, £229, £225, £224, £220 etc. The 52kg plus averaged £197.56/hd. Every hogg in the market averaging £165.61/hd. A fantastic trade leading up to the Easter Bank Holiday weekend. An SQQ of 379p/kg and overall 372.88p/kg.

A quite phenomenal day - with the entry up 500 head and prices up over £25/head. Demand fuelled by lesser numbers elsewhere with buyers anxious to fulfil orders. Good show of purebreds, top price of £285, with others from £236 to £274. Best of the crossbreds up to £170 with any amount of the weighted sheep from £145 to £160. Plenty of half meated Suffolks and Texels from £120 to £140 with only the very light and lean around £100. Mules a fantastic trade, best sheep over £140, plenty between £125 and £135 with leaner penfuls around £100. Hillbreds well represented, with strong Cheviots to £110, lots of pens between £80 and £90. Very few animals sold below £60 and the average of £131 very satisfactory, reflecting the excellent demand and a better quality entry.

Rams thin on the ground but easy to sell, top price highest for a long time at £210 from Mark Lloyd, Sarnesfield, an average of £129.

Good supply of goats and once again a wonderful trade, top price of £155 and an average of £116.
