PRIME HOGGS - 768

A very varied show of hogsgs with several last draw's forward, which without a doubt would drag the averages back nevertheless the 45kg to 52kg averaged 379p/kg with an overall average achieved of 370p/kg topping at 435p/kg for 40.5kg hoggs from D G Morgan & Sons, another pen of 40kg from D G Whistance sailing to 433p/kg as did a pen of 40.5kg from E Williams, Panthwdog.

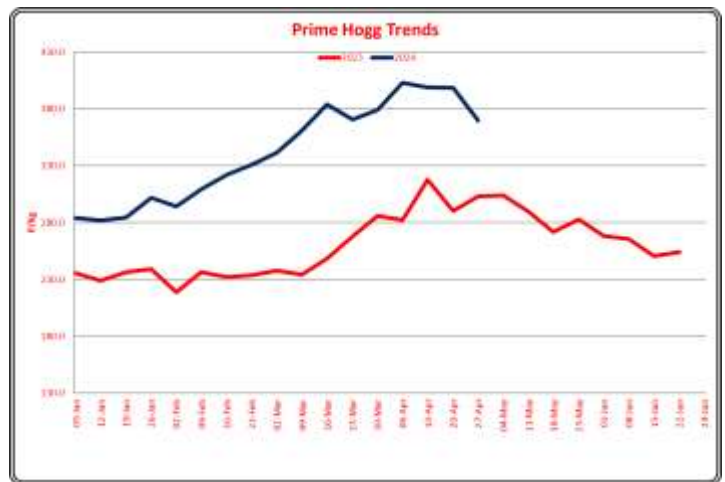
An exceptional run of 143 meated hoggs from M/s Dunswater Farms averaged 50.8kg and 391p/kg or £198.52/head. Another good run of meated hoggs from Perry Hill averaged a super £207.40/head up to £220.50/head for a pen of 61.5kg.

The meat & quality was a pleasure to sell and easily placed and just as dear as we have seen in recent weeks. The heavies, the same story topping at 241p/kg for 72kg from J L & K H Nixon, others at £237, £228, £224 twice, £223 etc.

A varied entry of spring lambs with a majority of heavier Dorset lambs forward. There is certainly more demand for the lighter lambs at the moment under 42kg. Firms still very much preferring hogs as not enough spring lambs to switch over yet.

A selective trade which has not been helped by the forthcoming French Bank Holiday next week but nevertheless the better continental lambs selling to 456p/kg for 34kg from E Williams and 42.5kg from K F & C O Lawrence, Weston Green selling to 449p/kg or £191/head. Another pen from D & C Bishop selling to 439p/kg. The springers topped at £207/head for 55kg and £205/head for 53.5kg.

The SQQ of the lambs levelling at 409p/kg which is more of a notification of the type and weight of the lambs forward.

Pure breeds once again caught the eye, top of £242 with a bunch of 14 at £214, and a lot of 16 at £202. The best of the Suffolk cross edging £200 with plenty trading between £160 to £180, with some very good examples forward. All breeds very well bid for with two purchasers returning to the fold. Mules to £170 regularly £150 and some of the sheep generally from £100 to £120 had to be seen to be believed.

Rams probably having the best competition for weeks, top of £208 and averaging £151.
