A few more hoggs forward with trade carrying on at a frantic pace. All hoggs fiercely competed for and some hoggs looking the dearest we have seen.

Very little strength on offer but still topping at £167, £162, £159 and £154.50 twice, several others from £140 to £150. Farming hoggs included several grassy sorts with the well bred hoggs £125-£140. Plenty trading in the £130's. Smaller and leaner sorts £115-£125. Very few hoggs under £100. Longer keep better hoggs from £90-£110 with the majority £100 plus. Only a handful under £80.

Ram hoggs to £162, other stronger types £130-£150, smaller sorts included hill sorts from £105-£125. More can be sold each week to advantage with hoggs going to be required for the next few weeks.

BREEDING SHEEP

COUPLES - 497 ewes/701 lambs

An enlarged entry of couples coinciding with the annual show & sale with trade much improved on the week following the long-awaited improvement in weather.

The pre-sale show was ably judged by Rhodri and Aled Davies, Cwmcowddu Farm, who presented the Champion rosette to the Cheacker Family of Ostbridge Manor Farm for an outstanding pen of Suffolk cross ewes with topping twin lambs. These went on to top the day's trade at £415 or £138.33 per life.

A tremendous consignment of full and broken mouthed ewes with sizeable singles from FJ & MD Beaumont, Pentre Farm were also in the prizes and sold to £285 for Texel bred outfits, £275 for Mules and £250 for Suffolks.

Several younger ewes on offer with a super run of Texel and Suffolk bred outfits from Messrs Evans & Price, Llwynhywell seeing five rearing nine to £360 (£128.57 per life) & £355, twins to £352 and singles to £265 & £250. Another much fancied run of young ewes, this time from Harry & Rory Owen, Danybryn who saw six three-year-old Texel cross Mules with seven Charollais lambs realise £250, with yearlings to £280 for ewes with a lamb and a half.

Plenty of business done between £100 and £120 per life for strong crossbred outfits with the longer-term sorts generally in the £90s.

Older Mules very plentiful which is to be expected for the time of year, with singles to £275 as stated before. Other full mouthed and brokers with strong singles to £222 from RB & DM Read, Upper Marston. Smaller Mule ewes with one generally ranging between £150 and £190 depending on strength with the majority £160 to £185. Twins up to £270 with several £240 to £260. Older and more tired looking ewes with younger lambs generally from £210 to £220 with very small types £180 to £205. Mules with a lamb and a half to £262 (£104.80 per life).

Plenty of Welsh ewes now making an appearance with these easier sold on the week. Brokers with strong singles to £150 from Tom Davies, Y Dderw who sold two other bunches at £138. Several hardier bred Welsh ewes with one trading £110 to £130 and looking well sold. Plainer sorts and outfits with very young lambs generally £45 to £55 per life.

A Badger Faced Mule ewe and single lamb was kindly sold on behalf of Parkinsons UK after being donated by Mr H Morgan, Pencelli Court. The outfit went on to make £330, raising money for a very worthy cause.
